- A durable Kentucky bluegrass (*Poa pratensis*) variety, **Action** features a deep, aggressive rhizome system for improved drought recovery.
- Very quick to germinate and establish, **Action** is an ideal component for mixes designed to reduce soil erosion from wind and rain.
- **Action** is adapted to all areas of Kentucky bluegrass use, from coast to coast, and into the cooler portions of the Transition zone.
- **Action** has a fine leaf texture and an attractive spring-green color. Under environmental stresses, **Action** compares favorably to the Texas hybrid bluegrasses

PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS

LOW TO MODERATE MAINTENANCE:

With a low nitrogen requirement and quick establishment, **Action** is ideal for cool season mixes where ground coverage is the primary concern and maintenance budgets are low. Ideal for roadsides, parks, cemeteries, roadside berms, levees, and all low to moderately maintained turf areas.

FAST ESTABLISHMENT: Quick germination and establishment are very important keys when competing with other aggressive mix components such as perennial ryegrass, tall fescue, and fine fescues. Whereas many bluegrass components are often 'lost' in the mix due to slow establishment, **Action's** fast growth enables it to be a functioning, active mix component for years to come.

EARLY SPRING GREEN-UP: **Action's** early spring green-up is well suited for

areas with early spring use and for competing with spring weeds and other early spring cool-season grasses such as perennial ryegrass.

DROUGHT RECOVERY: Deep, thick rhizomes are a very important key to bluegrass survival during periods of drought and heat stress. Once established, **Action's** system of deep rhizomes provides a key to survival, helping to insure stand survival and safe, playable turf.

MIX RECOMMENDATIONS: **Action** is best mixed with perennial ryegrass and fine fescue at approximately 30-40% by weight. When mixed with tall fescue, 10-20%.

RECOMMENDED SEEDING RATES:

New establishment:
2-3 lbs./1,000 sq. ft. (or 10-15g/M²)
Overseeding into existing turf:
3-4 lbs./ 1,000 sq. ft. (or 15-20g/M²)
